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youth have the same rights as other students experiencing homelessness to enroll in, attend, and succeed in school.

To enroll an unaccompanied youth the school shall contact the district Homeless Education Liaison who will assist in this process. The unaccompanied youth must fill out a F.I.T. Standard Intake Form.

Enrollment Disputes: If a dispute arises over school selection or enrollment, the child/youth must be immediately admitted to the school in which he/she is seeking enrollment pending resolution of the dispute. [Sec. 722 (g)(3)(E)(i)]
